Brief summary:

During the past 10 weeks the CCG has also developed an Out of Hospital Strategy with options for commissioning a sustainable model of care.

This update outlines our vision, health needs, engagement and financial (inc. QIPP Plan) and our plans to provide more care closer to home.

The Governing Body is asked:

- 1. To note the recommendations**
- 2. To note the proposed clinical commissioning standards for care**
- 3. Support a public engagement process to develop the strategy**

Quality and patient safety issues: The strategy aims to improve the quality and safety of all services and has identified potential clinical commissioning standards based on members' feedback.

Financial issues: If implemented the strategy would have significant financial implications, including the reconfiguration of existing funding and services, ensuring more care is available in the community. A finance section is included in report.

Workforce issues: The workforce needed to deliver a new model of care would require training and continuing professional development.
